Thurs. Read the Psalm, God has given us mastery over much of creation. Do something new this week that shows your stewardship of that creation.

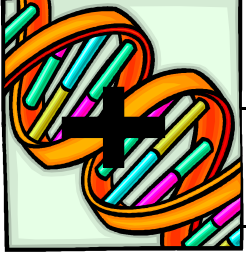
Fri. Read the John passage and then, write a fictitious story where the Holy Spirit is the main character. (Submit to the Life Links box)
